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Town of Chenango Yardwaste Rules & Regulations

1. **NO CONTRACTOR CLEAN UP** If you hire a contractor to perform work then the cost of clean up needs to be included in their quote. Large piles of brush that are left from contractor work *will not be picked up*.
2. Grass clippings and leaves must be placed in **open** plastic or metal garbage cans. **Do not use recycling bins for yardwaste or cans with attached lids or wheel barrels.**
3. The containers must not weigh more than **50 pounds** or they will not be picked up.
4. The **lids** must be **left off**, even if it rains or they will not be picked up.
5. Plastic bags may be used but they must be left **untied** and weigh no more than **50 pounds**.
6. Small brush may be placed in garbage cans or tied in bundles but must not weigh more than **50 pounds**.
7. Limbs that need to be chipped should not be larger than 4 inches in diameter and they must be at least **6 feet long**.
8. The **longer** the branches the better. They must be trimmed of any protruding branches and **stacked neatly in one direction** by the curb.
9. **No large piles** will be chipped without prior approval. Please note that chipping can often take more than one day to get done.
10. **Lot clearing** is the responsibility of the homeowner not the Town of Chenango.
11. **Am I on a regular route for yardwaste?** If you are in a rural area, you may not be a part of the scheduled weekly pickup. Please call or e-mail the department to verify your address if you live outside of the more populated areas. If you are outside the regularly scheduled service area a small truck will be dispatched to your address to provide you service.
